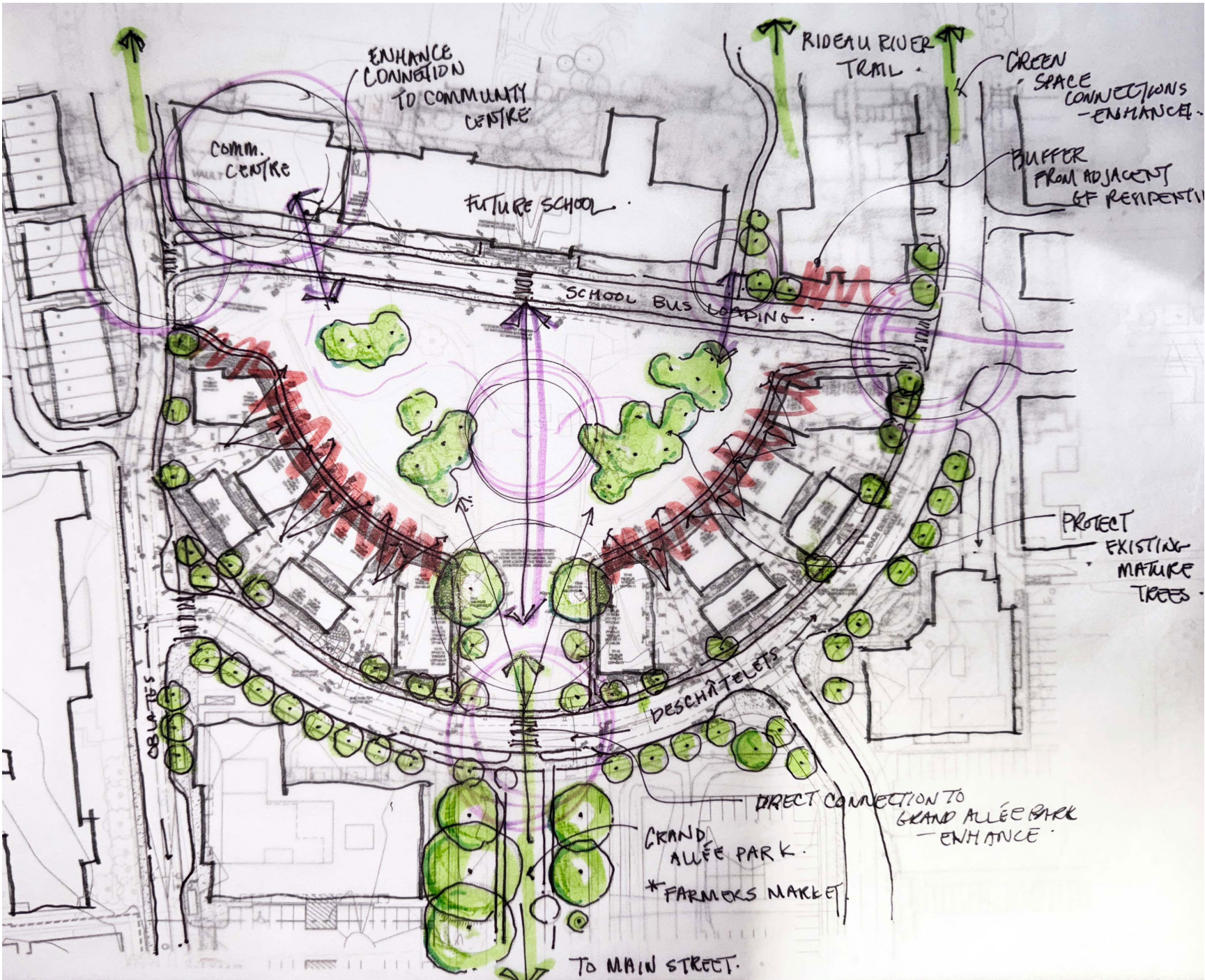
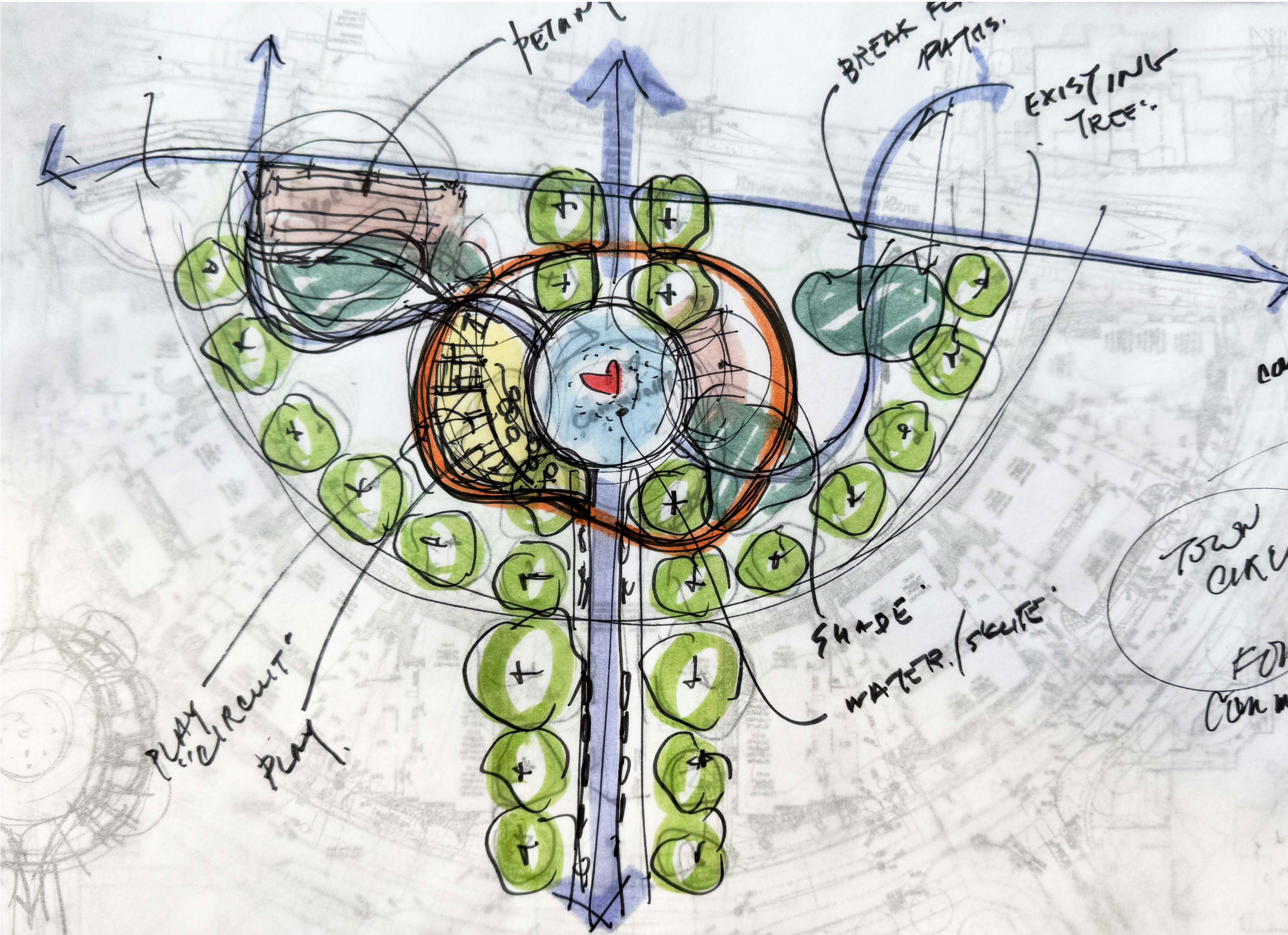


# CONTEXT

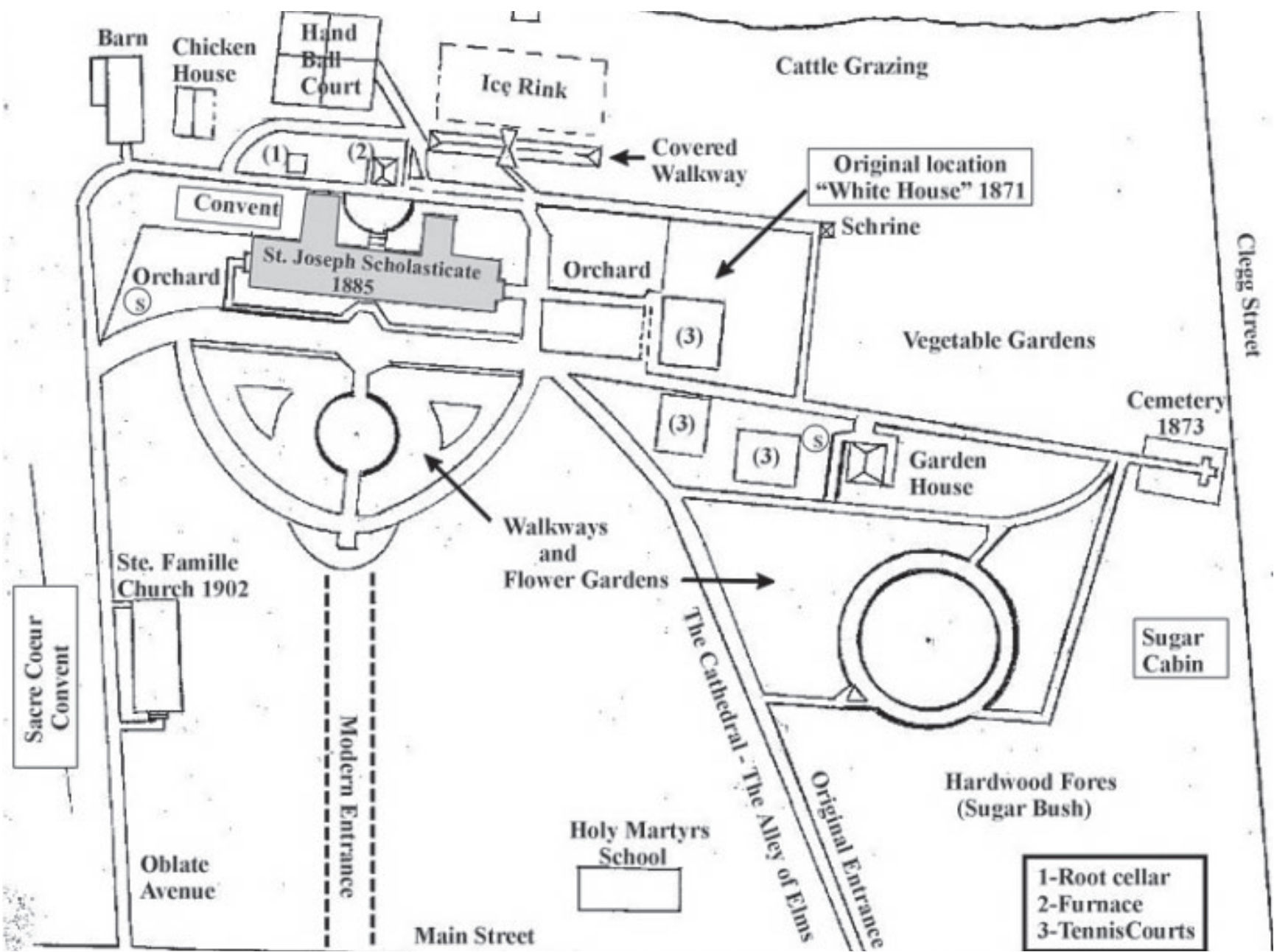


**PARK CONTEXT:** Forecourt Park is central to the Greystone Village development and former Oblate lands. The built context of the surrounding residential community, trail and pathway connections and existing Grand Allée Park reinforce a strong focussed view towards the Deschâtelets Building. Existing mature trees combined with the arc of the forecourt establish a node in the centre of the park land.



**DESIGN INTENT:** The heart of the Greystone Village development, Forecourt Park is a destination and community gathering hub for residents in Old Ottawa East. The concept design for the park focusses on a central community space, anchored by an extension of the Grand Allée. Formal tree planting along the arc and allée reinforce a historical nod to the Oblate lands and former land use.

The community centre is reinforced by a perimeter 'play circuit' to layer and support multi-generational programming throughout. Amenities such as petanque, chess, and climbing elements are integrated with interactive play components and an engaging, central water feature.

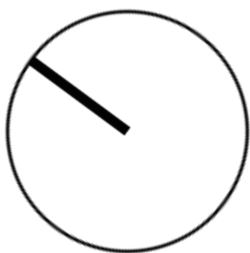

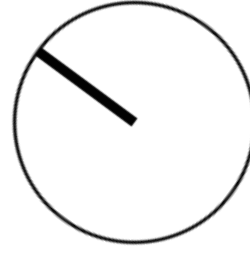
