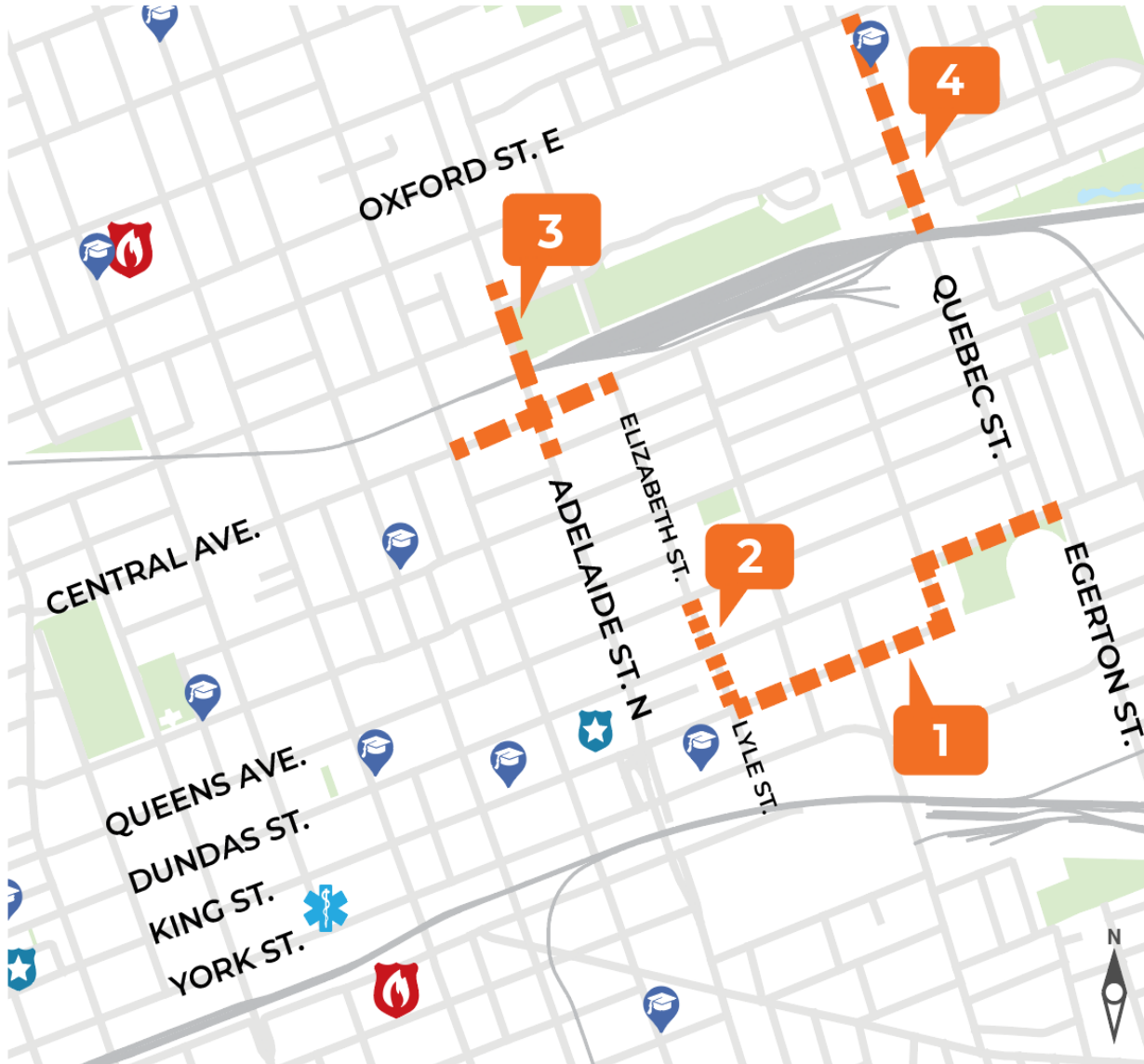

1 East London Link Phase 2

Timing: early March 2023 to end of year*

2 Elizabeth Street & Lyle Street Infrastructure Renewal

Timing: early May 2023 to end of year*

3 Adelaide Underpass

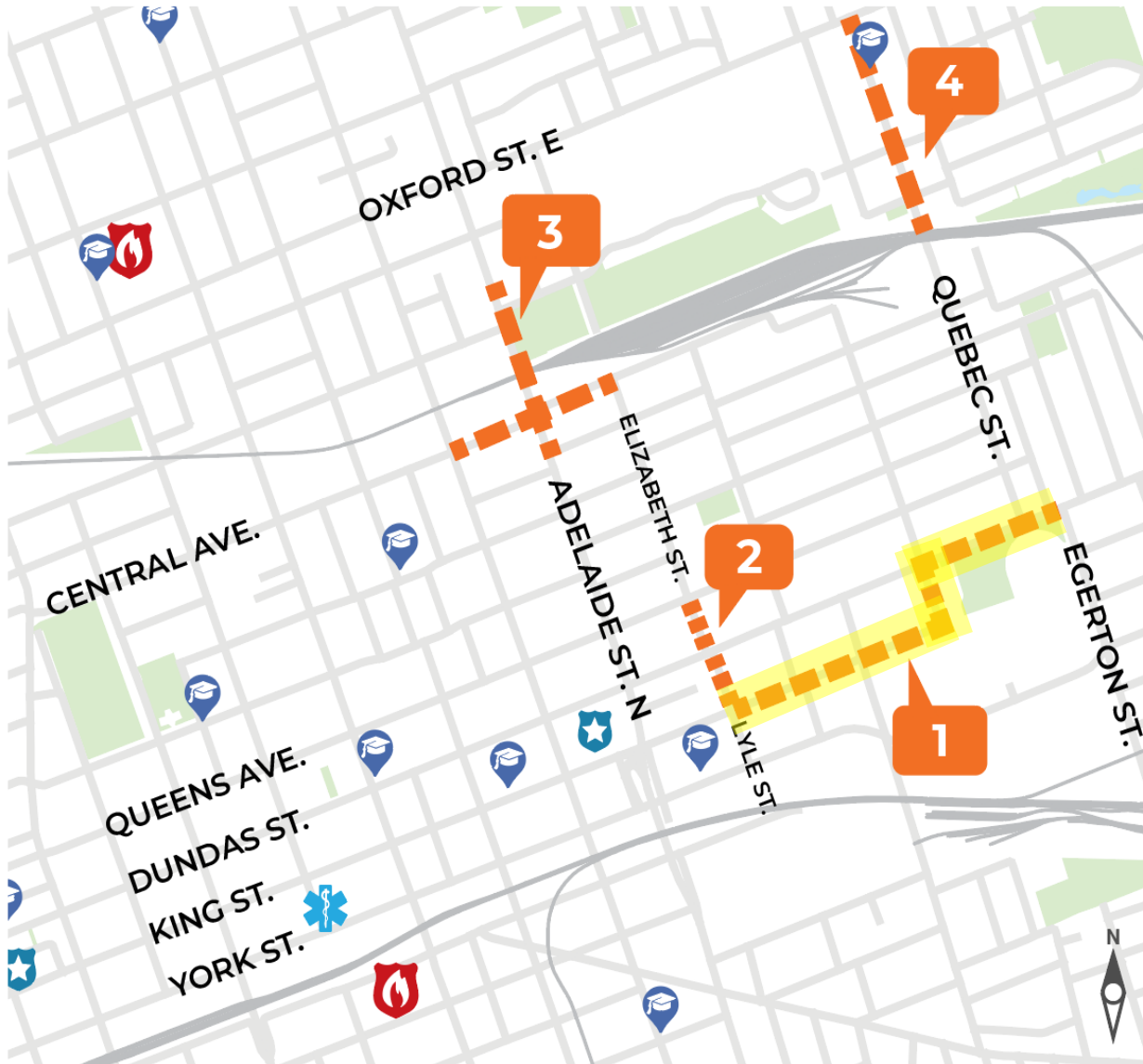
Construction is ongoing (multi-year)

4 Quebec Street Infrastructure Renewal

Timing: early May 2023 to end of year*

**Timing is approximate and subject to change depending on numerous factors, including weather, supply chain, etc.*

East London Link Phase 2

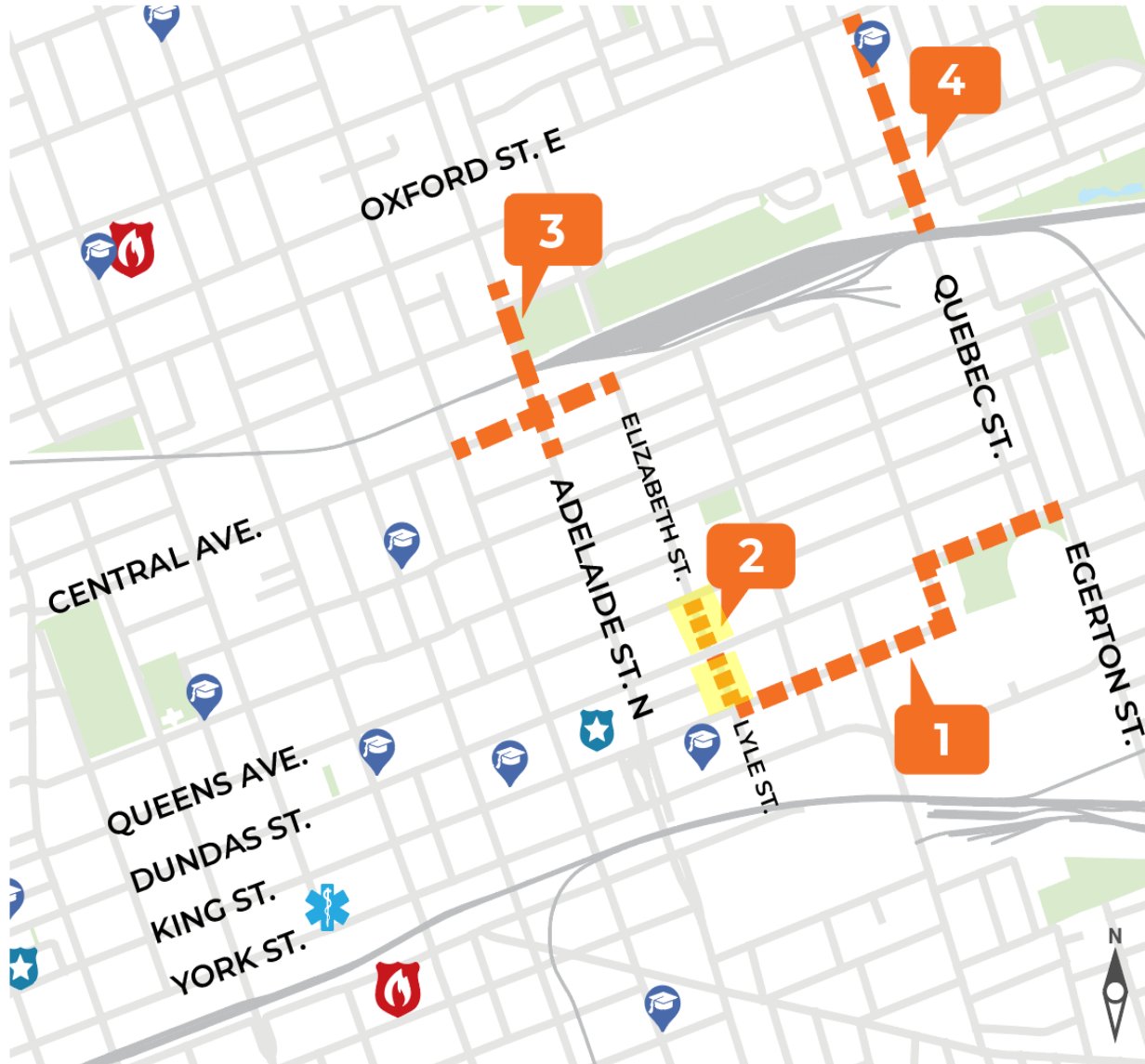


- Timing: March 2023, through to end of year. Some minor work in spring 2024
- Project limits: King Street just east of Lyle Street intersection to Ontario Street; Ontario Street (King to Dundas); Dundas Street from just west of Ontario to Egerton Street.
- Will be completed in stages to limit impacts.

Project limits and timing

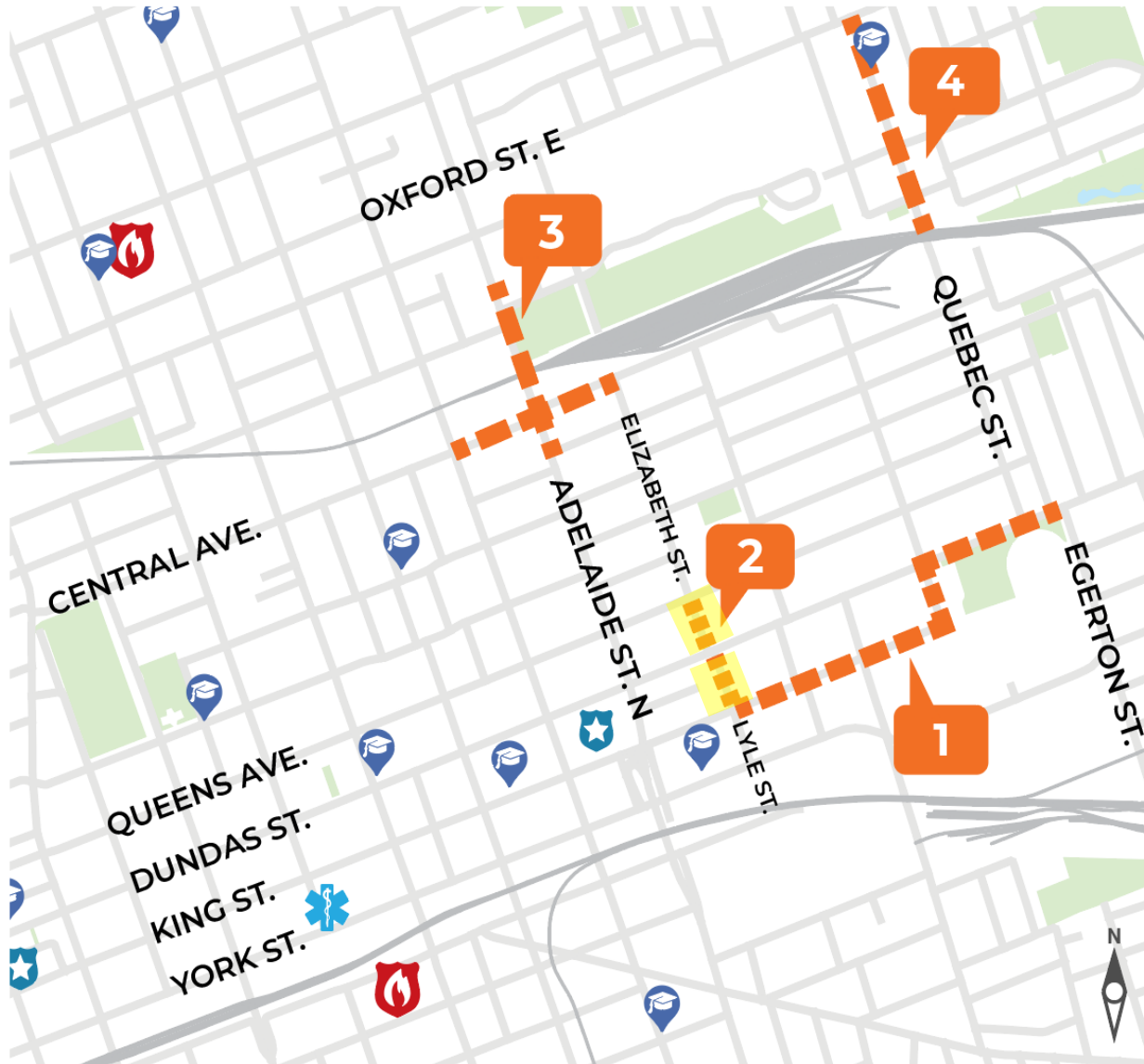


Timing: May 1, 2023, through to end of year.

Project limits: Lyle from King to Dundas;
Elizabeth from Dundas to Queens Ave

Traffic impacts

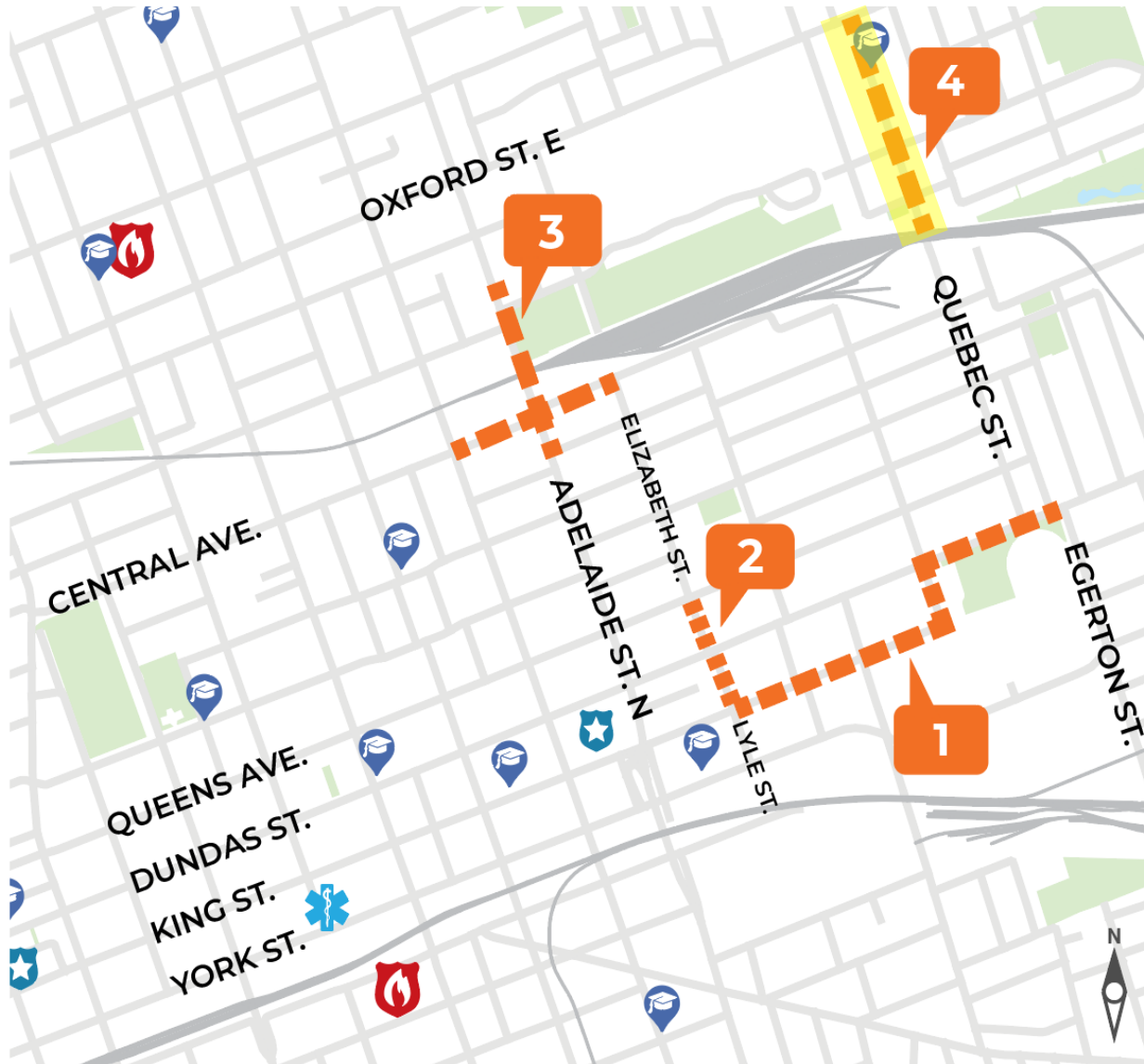


- Full road closure of Lyle and Elizabeth Streets (local traffic only), intermittent sidewalk closures and a partial intersection closure at Queens Avenue and Elizabeth Street
- No work along Dundas Street is proposed; Dundas Street will remain open during construction
- Will be completed in two stages to limit impacts:
 - Stage 1 is Lyle Street
 - Stage 2 is Elizabeth Street

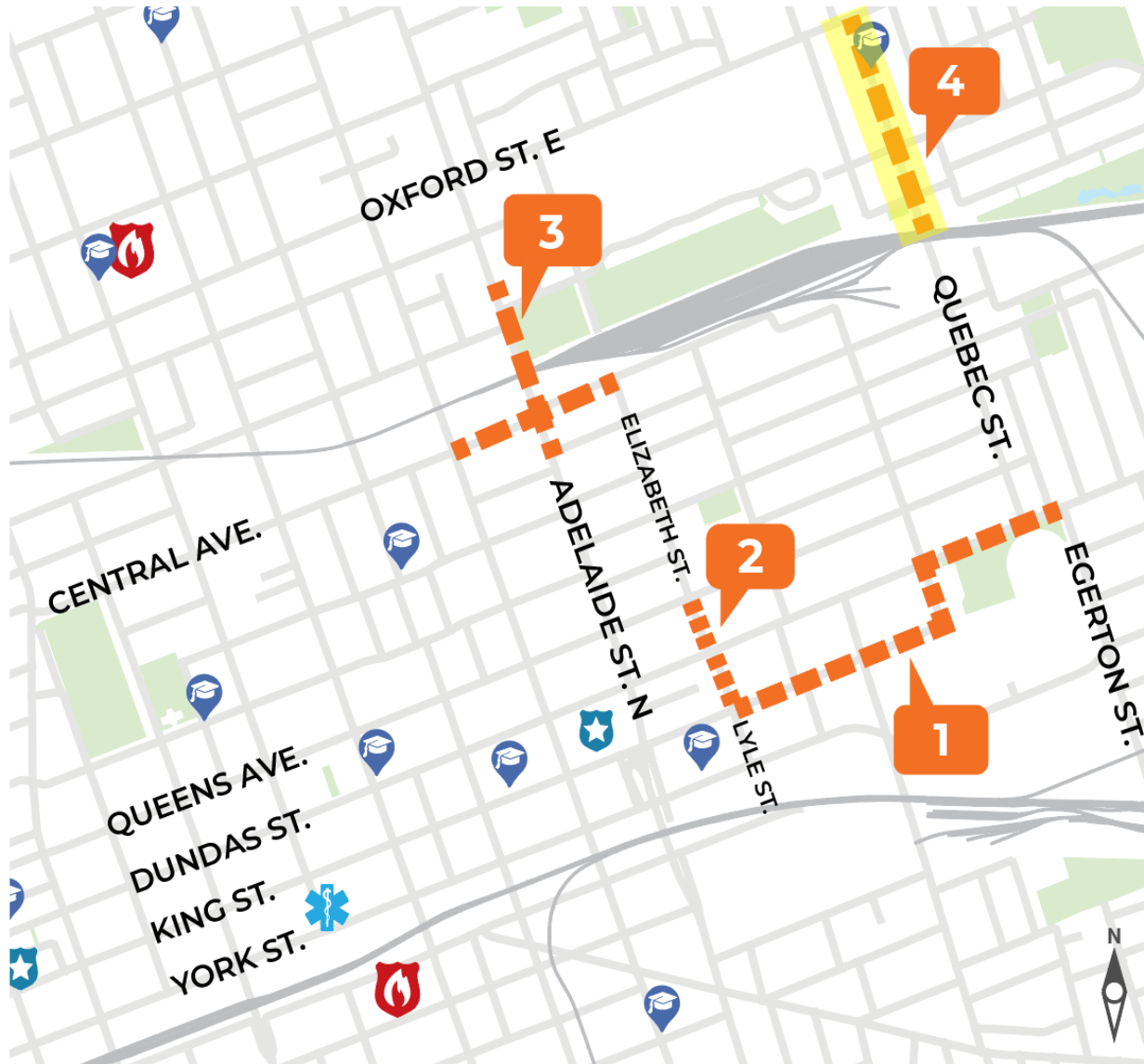
Project limits and timing



- **Timing:** May 1, 2023, through to end of year.
- **Project limits:** Quebec Street between Oxford Street and Salisbury Street, with some work in the Oxford/Quebec intersection required.

Quebec Street Infrastructure Renewal Project

Traffic impacts

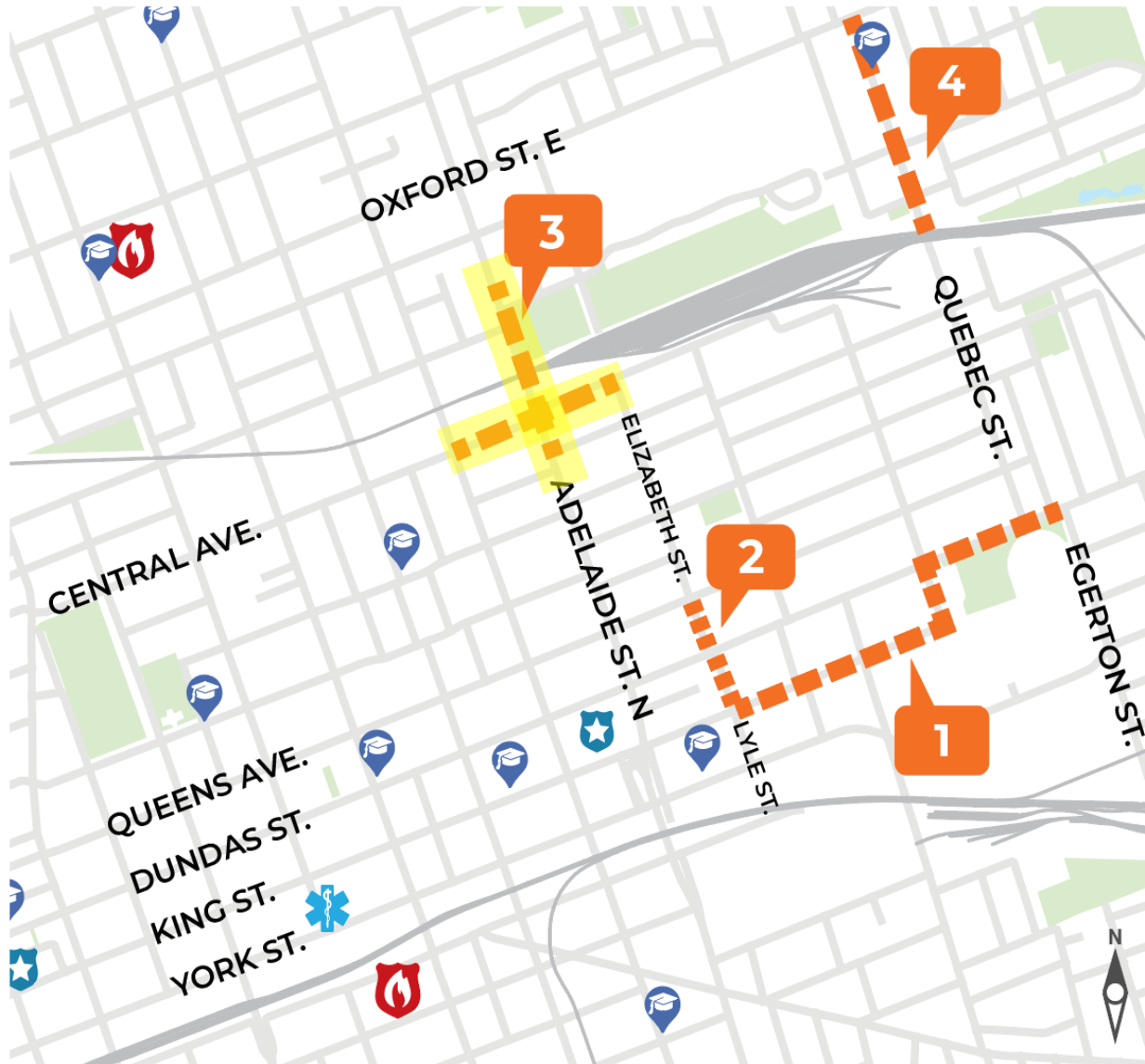


- Full road closure of Quebec Street (maintain local traffic only) from Elias Street to Oxford Street East, with intermittent sidewalk closures
- Partial intersection closure at Quebec Street/Oxford Street East intersection
- Intersection closures at Quebec Street/Mornington Avenue and Quebec Street/Salisbury Street.
- Access to local businesses and residences will be maintained.

Project limits and timing



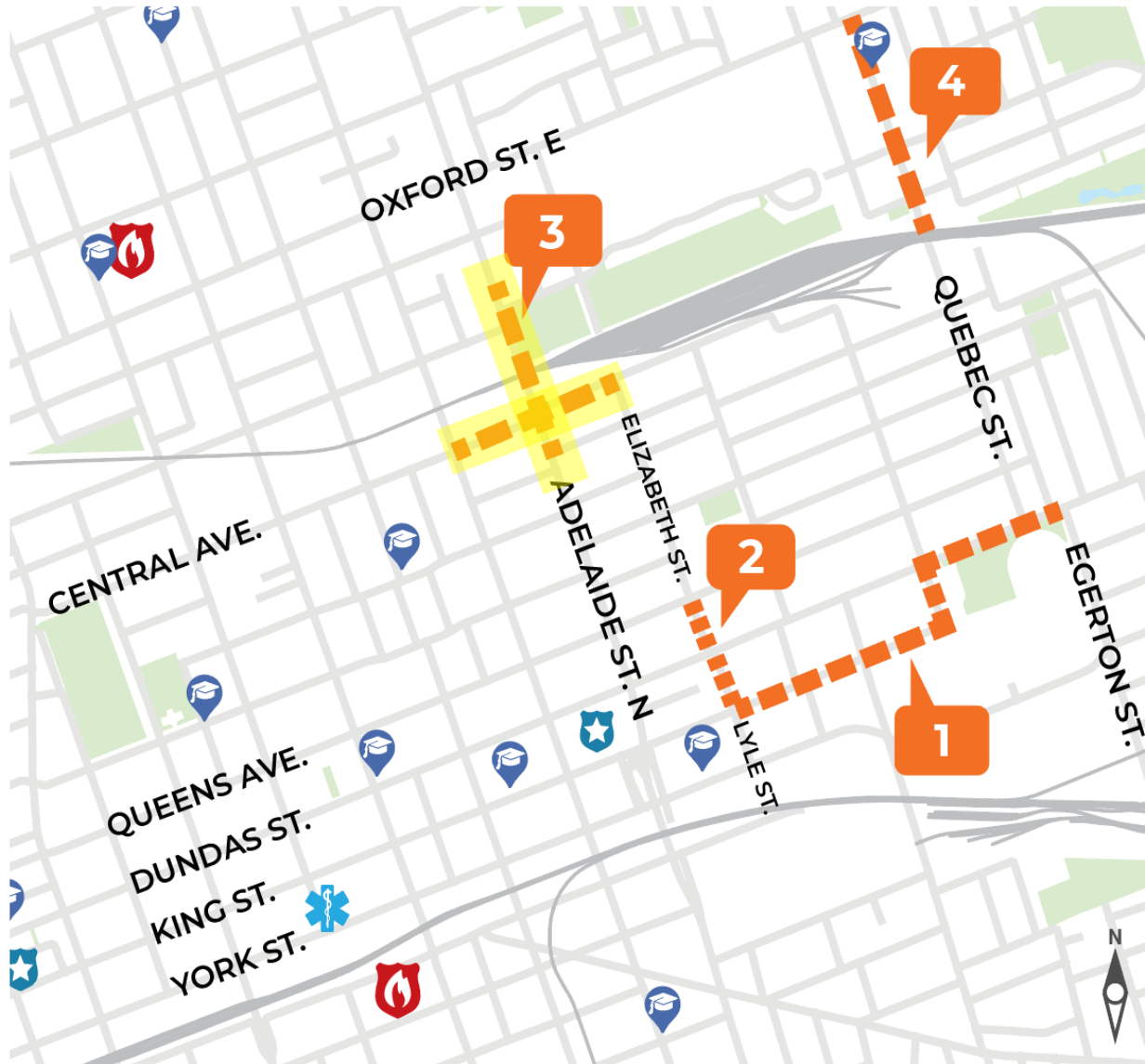
Project limits: Adelaide Street North from McMahon to just south of Central Avenue

Timing: Multi-year project, 2022 - 2024



Adelaide Underpass

Traffic impacts



- Lane restrictions on Adelaide Street between McMahon Street and just south of Central Avenue
- Temporary bypass road in place to maintain one lane northbound and one lane southbound at all times

③ Wellington Gateway (2023 – 2026)

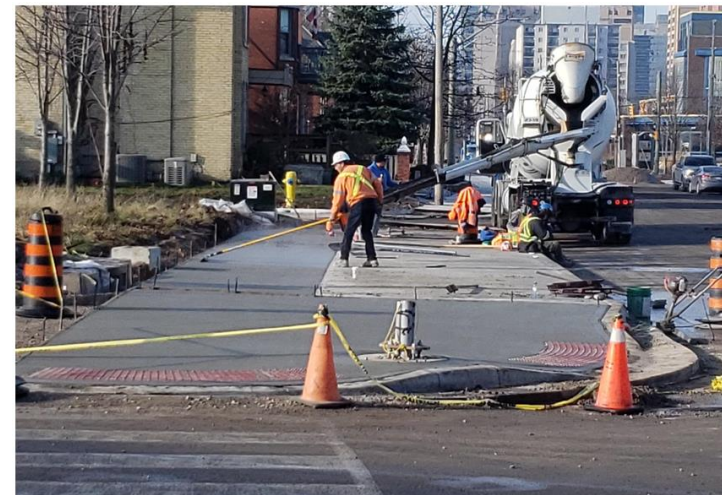

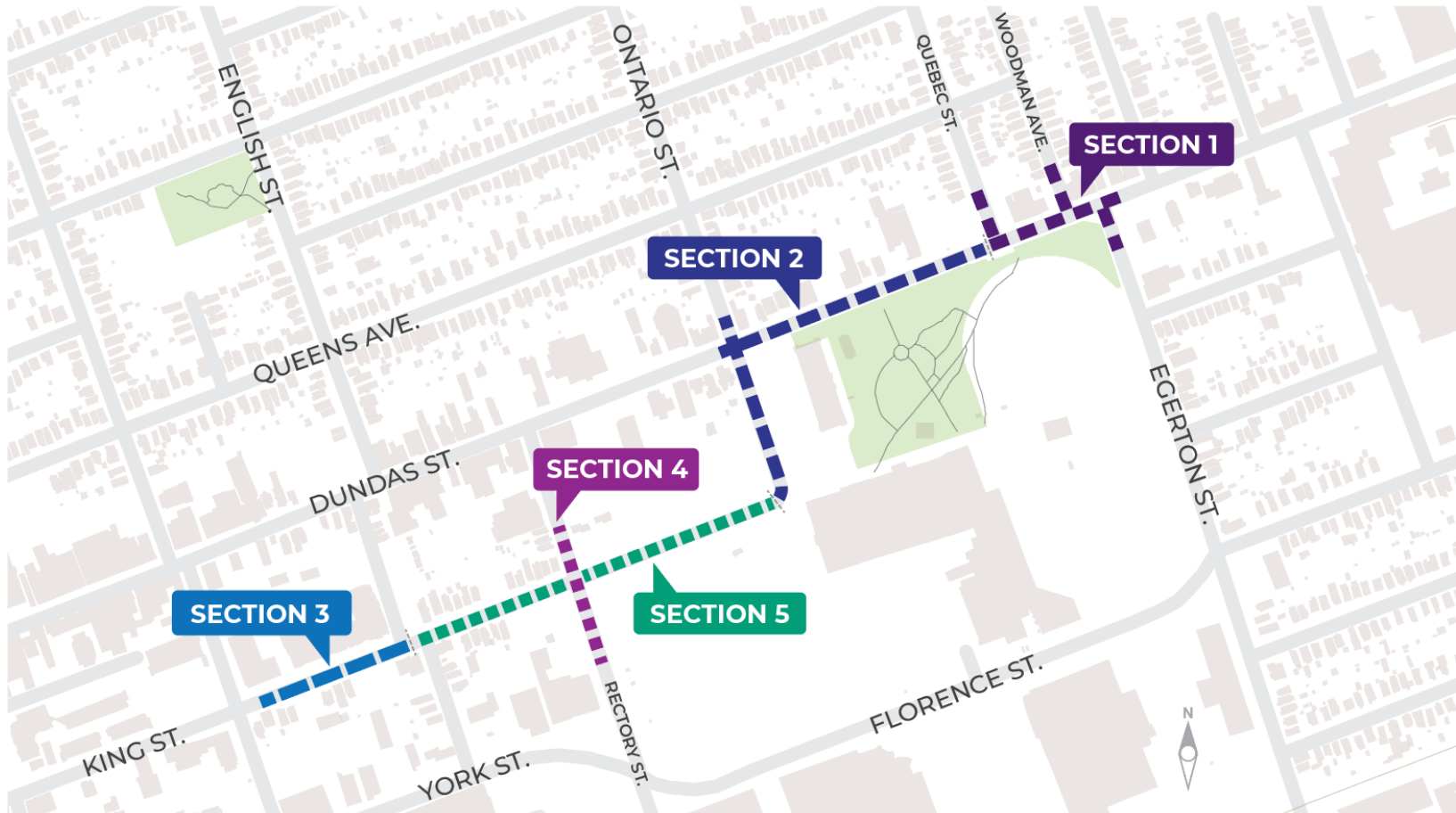
- Will be completed in stages to limit impacts.

- Completing largescale surface removals across the entire project area allows us to address any findings we encounter as early as possible, and adjust staging if necessary

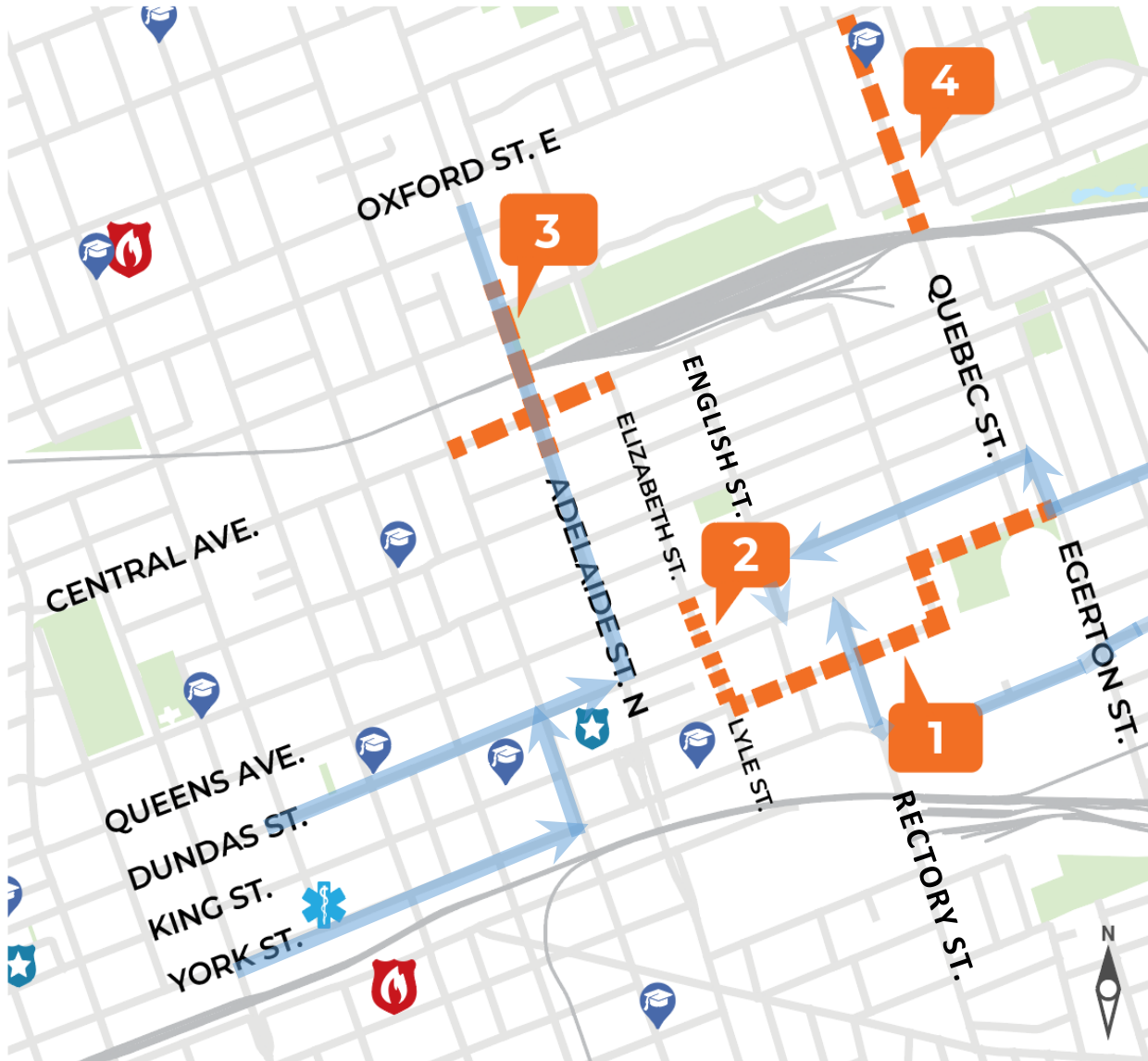


East London Link Phase 2 – Construction Stages

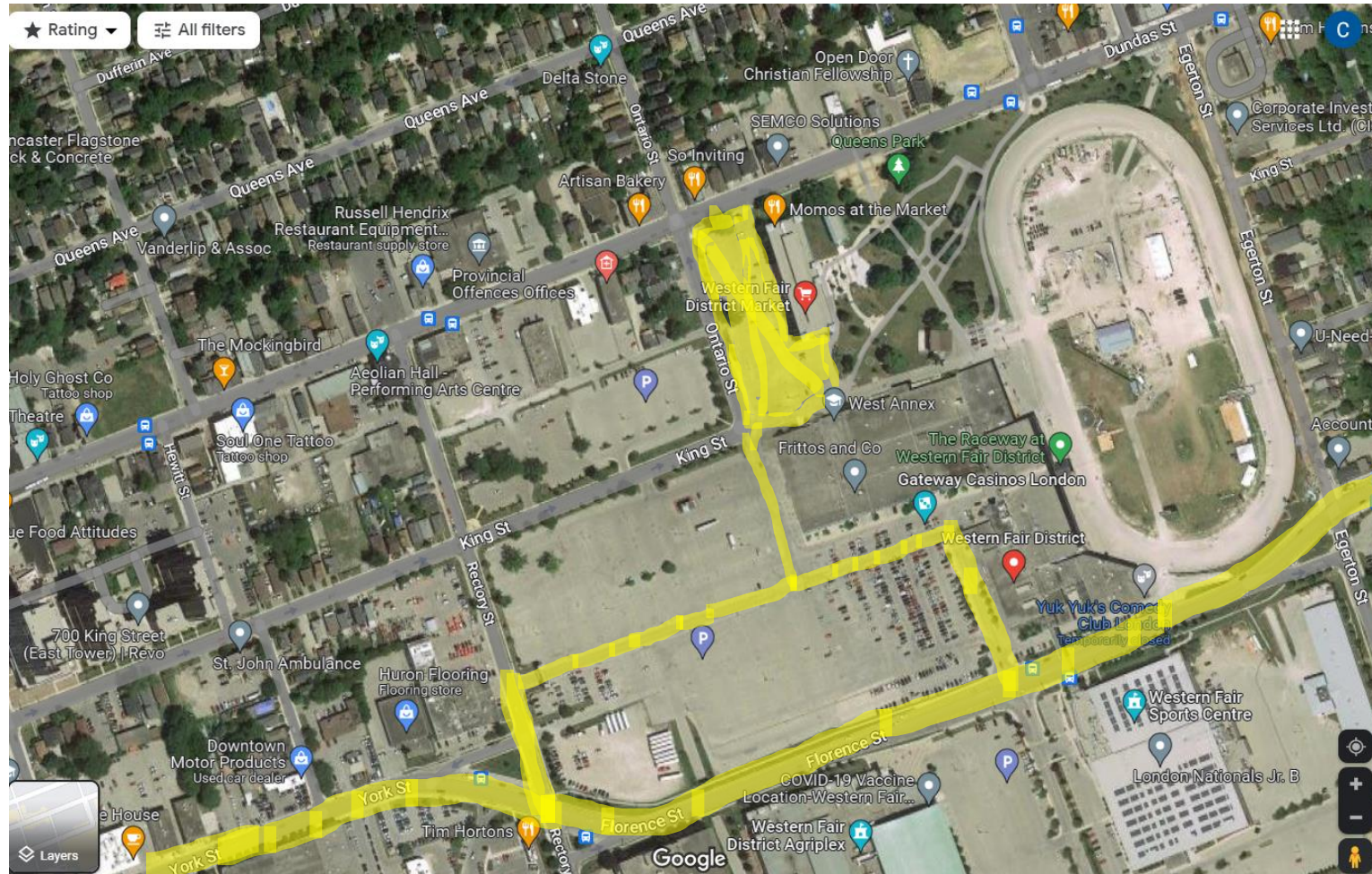

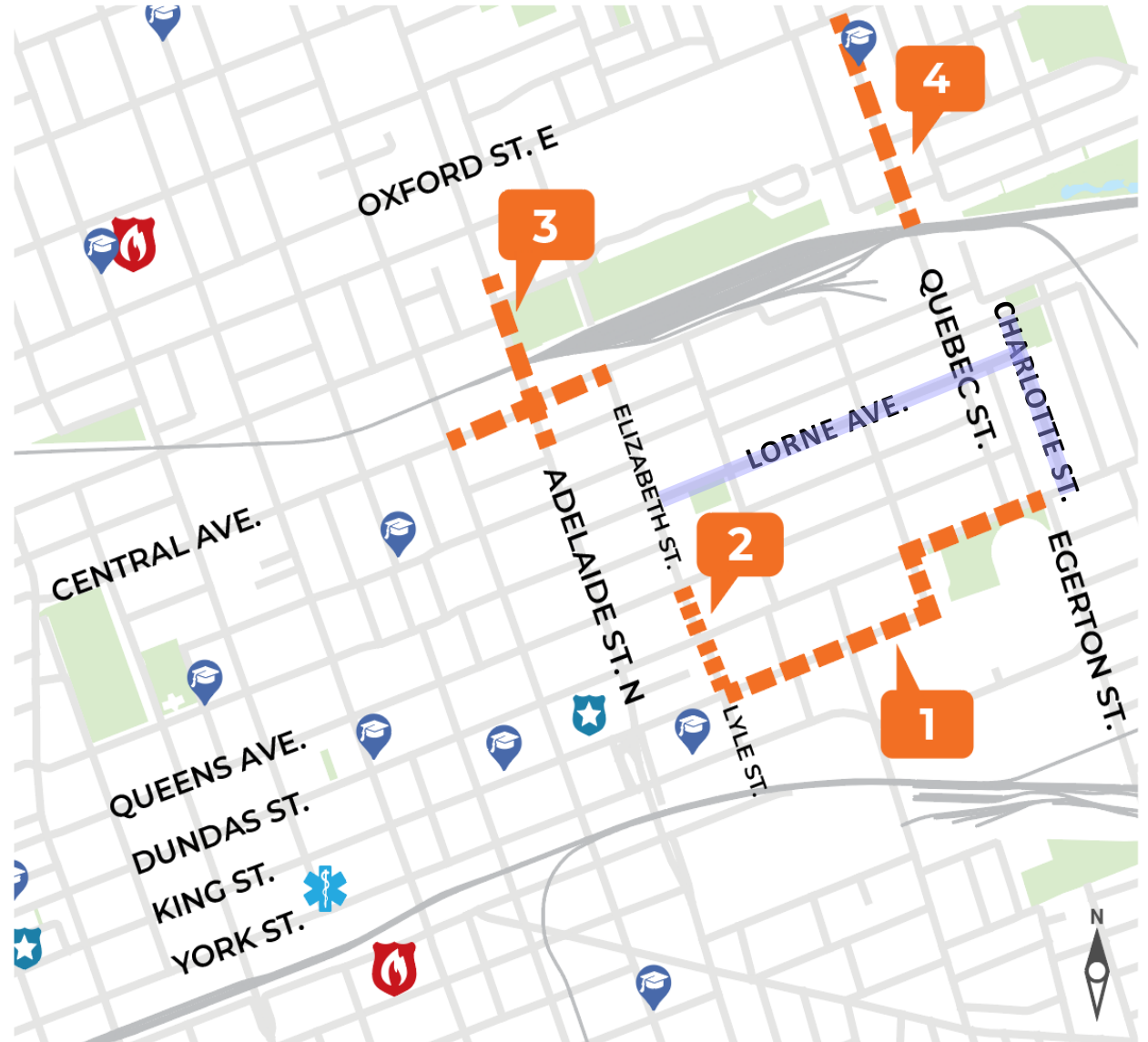

Traffic calming measures

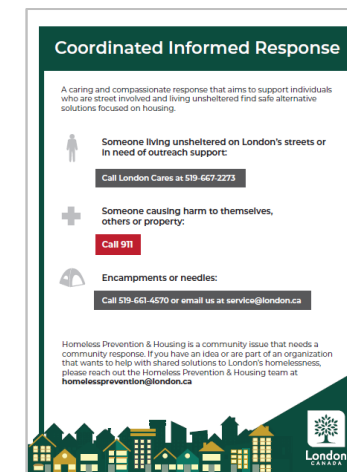
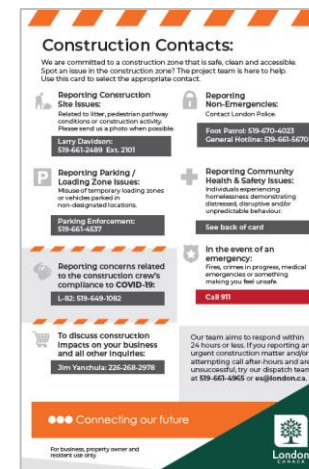
- Temporary traffic calming features are being added in the OEV neighbourhood, with a focus on Lorne Avenue and Charlotte Street
- Installation is planned for April



Security

Site security and safety

- Coordination will continue with Community Informed Response (CIR)
- Private security will once again be provided through the RT contract
- Security and safety plans are being developed for non-RT projects as well
- City Staff are working with contractors and site inspectors to provide additional monitoring of site management, including checking that materials that could be used to damage nearby properties are secured as much as possible.
