Consultation process on the future of Chinatown 2019: Building a Vibrant Chinatown Together

1. Context

The Borough of Ville-Marie, in partnership with the Centre d'écologie urbaine de Montréal has formed an advisory committee in order to orchestrate a consultation process that will reach the largest number of participants.

2. Committee's mandate

The committee is in charge of **monitoring**, **validating**, **enriching** and **sharing** the different steps of the **consultation** process.

Three meetings are scheduled. The first meeting, held on June 20, 2019, aimed to:

- Introduce the actors, along with their interest in and expectations of the consultation process.
- Identify the issues to consider in the process.
- Receive comments and suggestions on the public consultation process.

3. Composition

These meetings are led by the Centre d'écologie urbaine de Montréal and are by invitation. Representatives of the following organizations have been invited to participate:
