

Park Restoration - Ivey Park

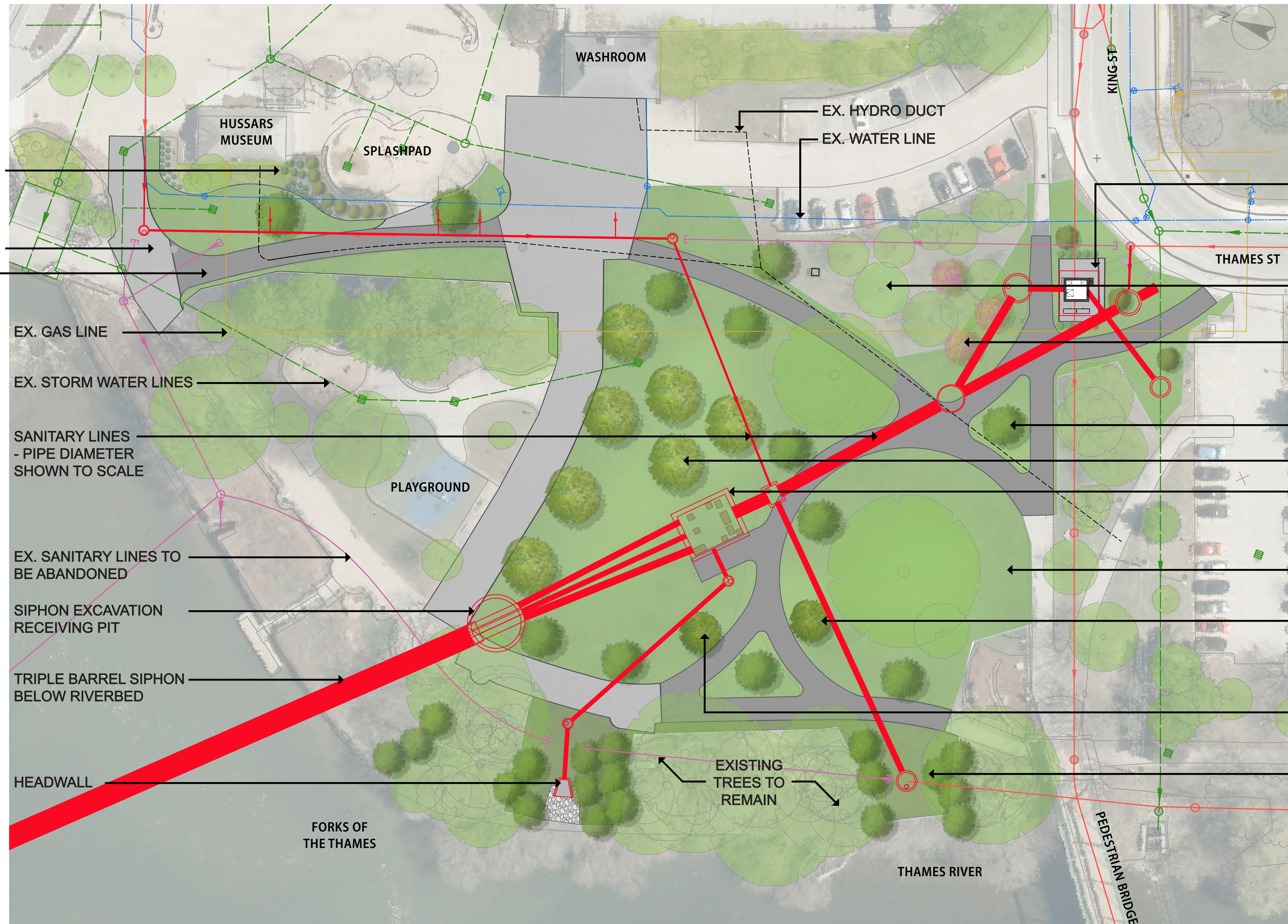
Restoration Notes

Restoration efforts in Ivey Park will include new concrete and asphalt paths, refurbishment of all park signs and furnishings, proposed tree planting including large caliper trees to be spaded in, replacement of two memorial trees, topsoil and sod.
