

NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

RAIL TRAIL CONNECTION FROM MARLATTS ROAD TO THE WELLAND CANAL TRAIL

MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY

THE STUDY

The **City of Thorold** has completed a Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) for an active transportation connection between the existing Rail Trail and the Welland Canal Trail in the City of Thorold, within the Regional Municipality of Niagara (see key map).

Following consultation with the public, key stakeholders, Indigenous Communities, and external agencies, a recommended connection between the Rail Trail and Welland Canal Trail has been identified. The recommended connection includes a multi-use trail facility along Beaverdams Road and Ormond Street South, connecting the Rail Trail trailhead to the Welland Canal Trail.

PROJECT FILE REPORT REVIEW PERIOD

This Study was completed as a Schedule 'B' project in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, as amended (October 2000, amended 2007, 2011, 2015, 2023 and 2024).

A Project File Report (PFR) has been prepared to document the study process, existing conditions, identification and evaluation of alternative trail alignments and facility types, the recommended alternative, potential environmental impacts and recommended mitigation measures, and engagement activities undertaken. The PFR is being made available for a 30-day review period from **January 12, 2026 to February 11, 2026**.

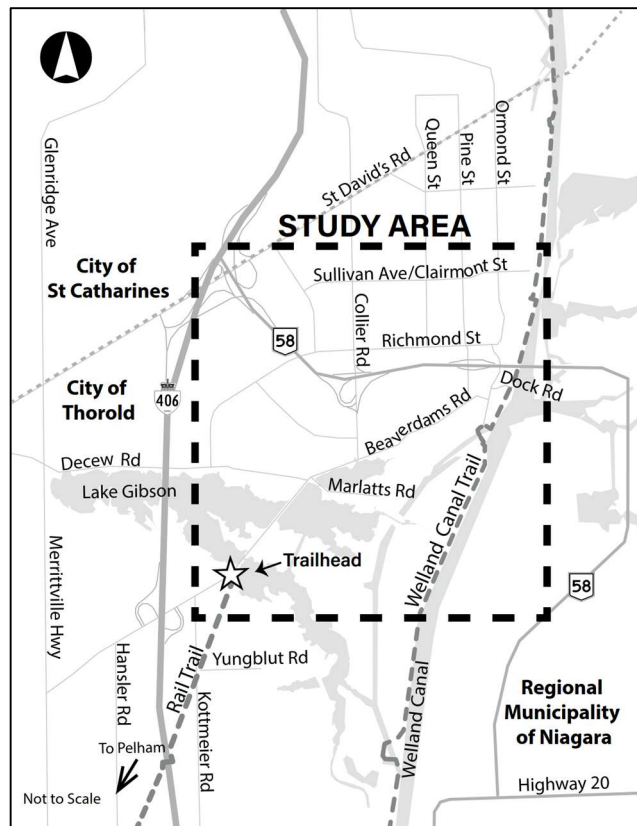
