In June 2025, bus routes will begin moving off Graham Avenue as planned in the Winnipeg Transit Master Plan.

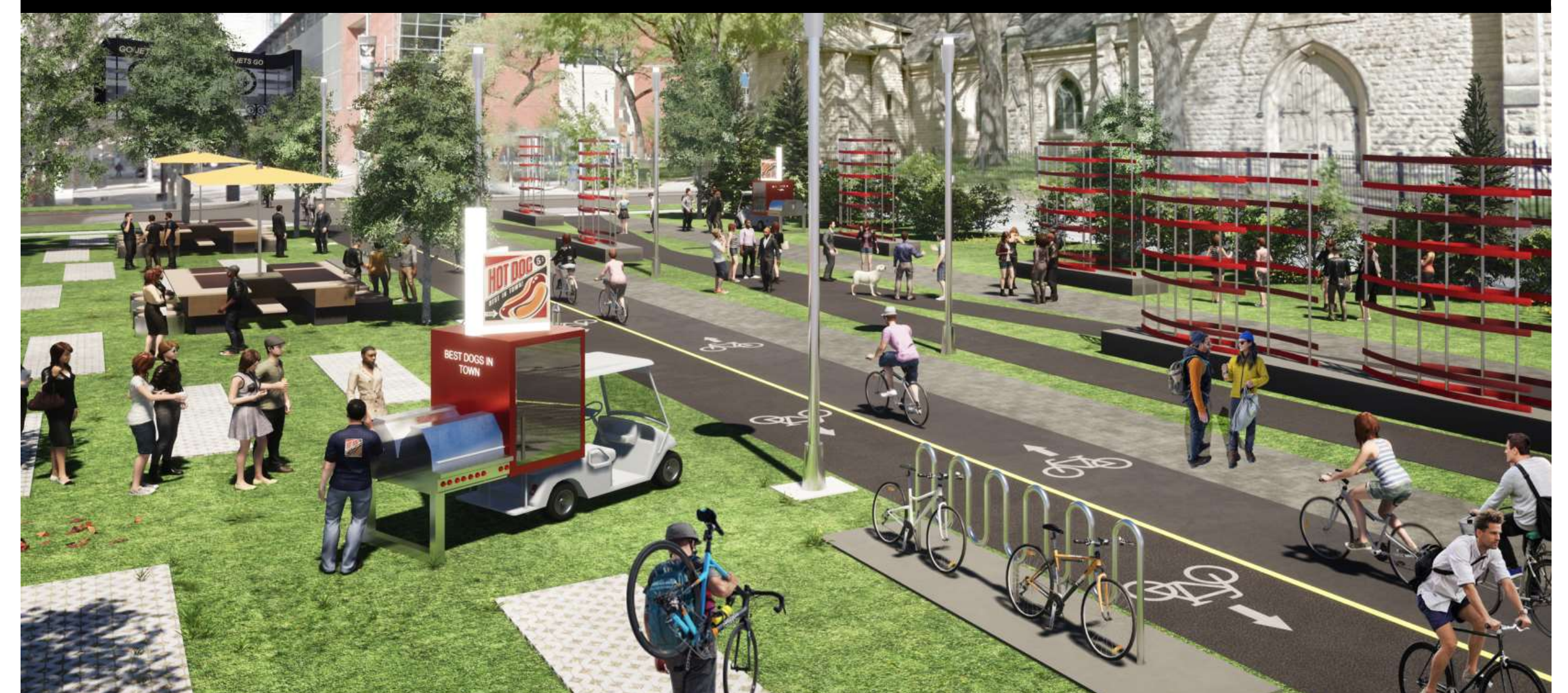
This gives us an incredible opportunity to re-imagine how we use Graham Avenue.

In the Shared Zone cars would be permitted; however, more space would be dedicated to pedestrians, cyclists, and patios.

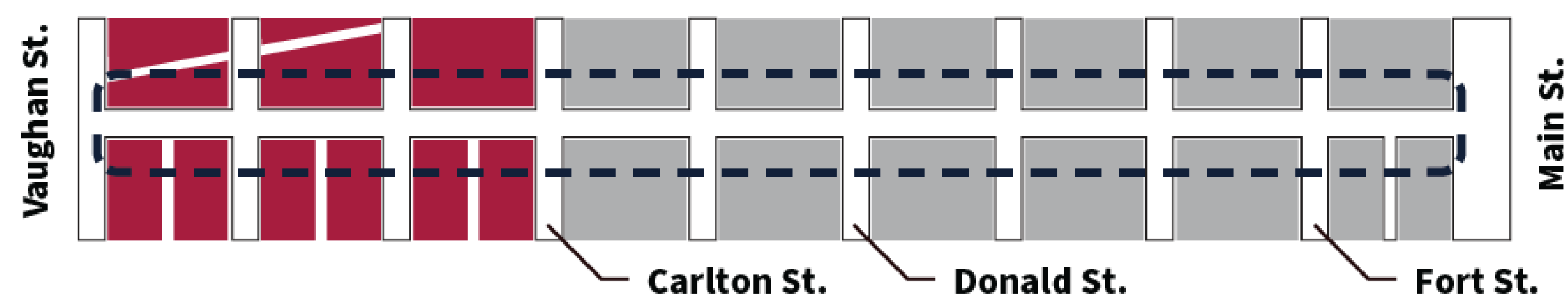
What Graham Avenue at Kennedy Street could look like tomorrow



What Graham Avenue at Edmonton Street could look like tomorrow

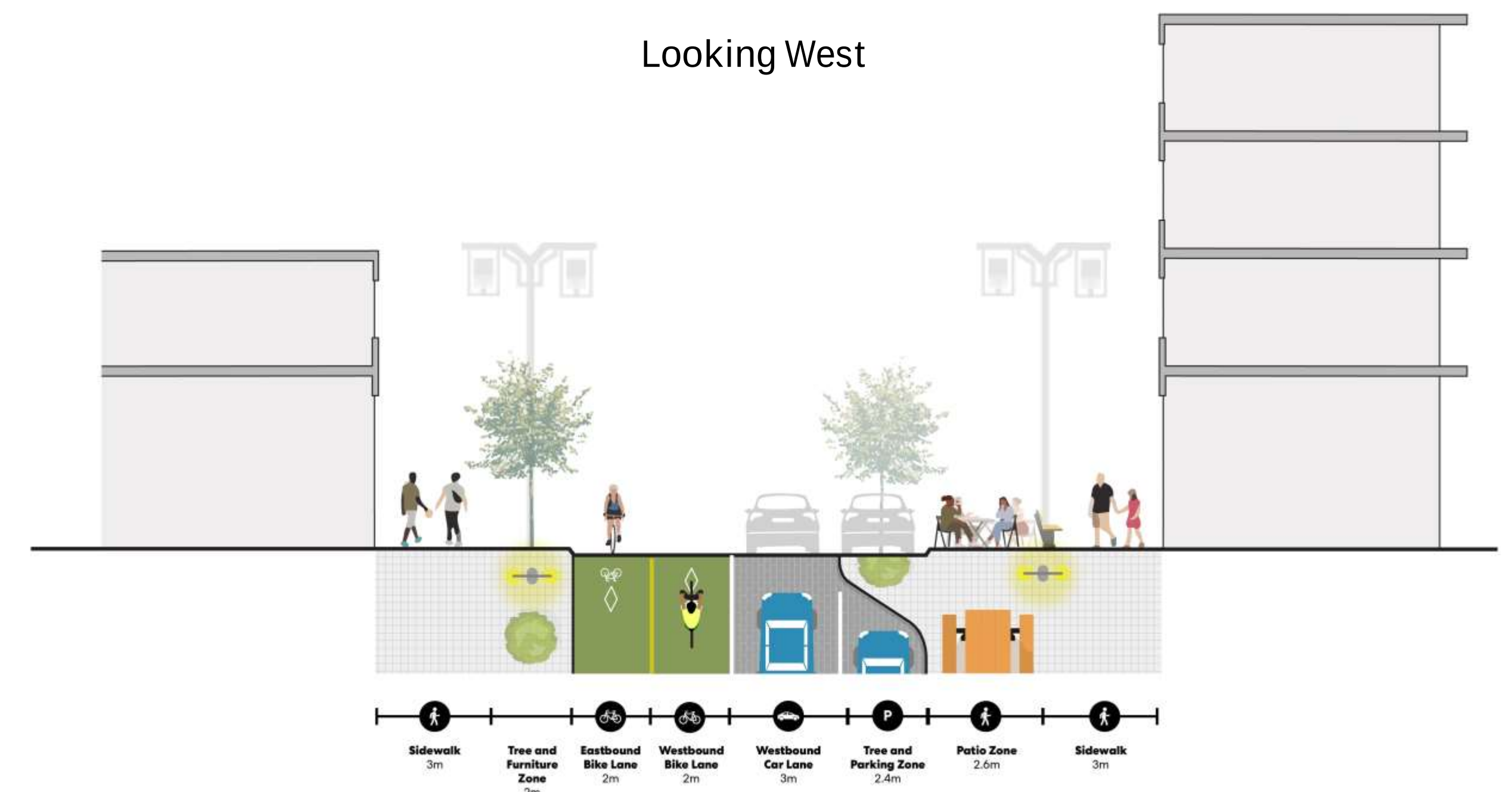

The Celebration Zone would be the new destination for street parties in the Downtown - from Winnipeg **Jets' Whiteout parties to food truck festivals and beyond.**

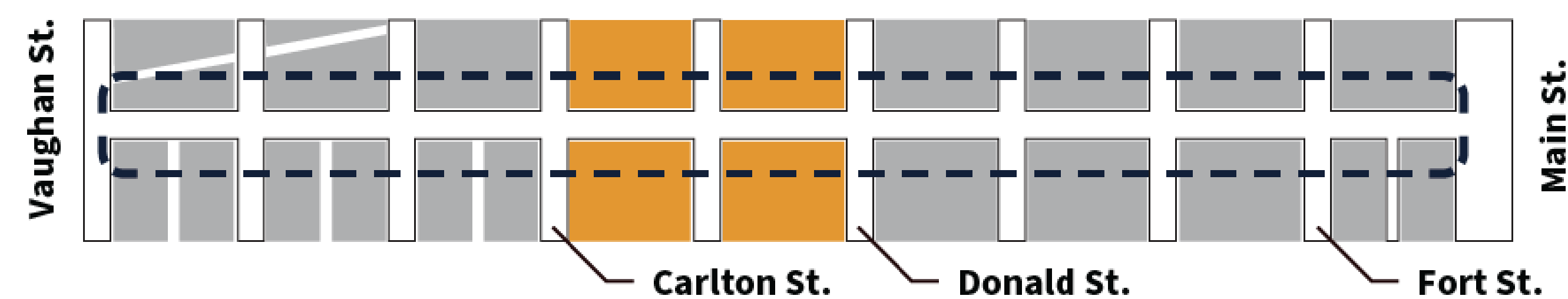
What Graham Avenue at Donald Street could look like tomorrow

In the Green Zone, significant space would be dedicated to trees, plantings, recreational amenities, and seating.

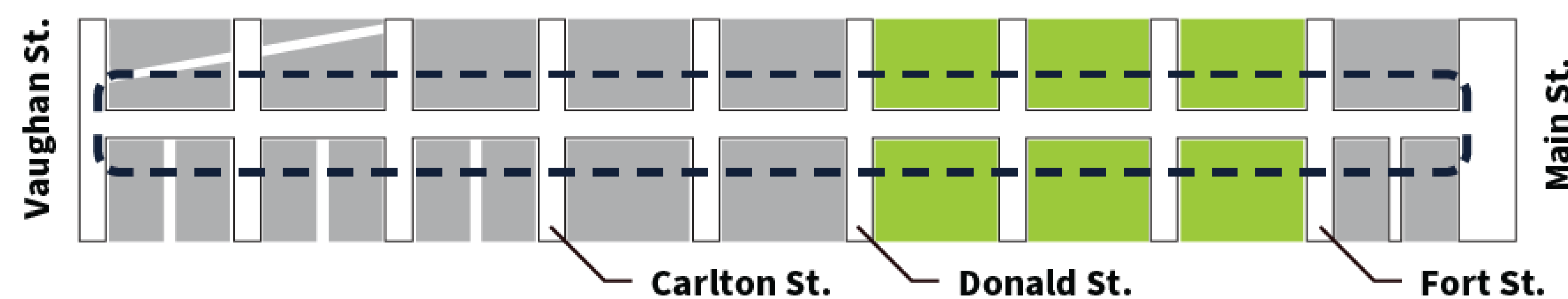
What Graham Avenue at Smith Street could look like tomorrow



What Graham Avenue at Garry Street could look like tomorrow

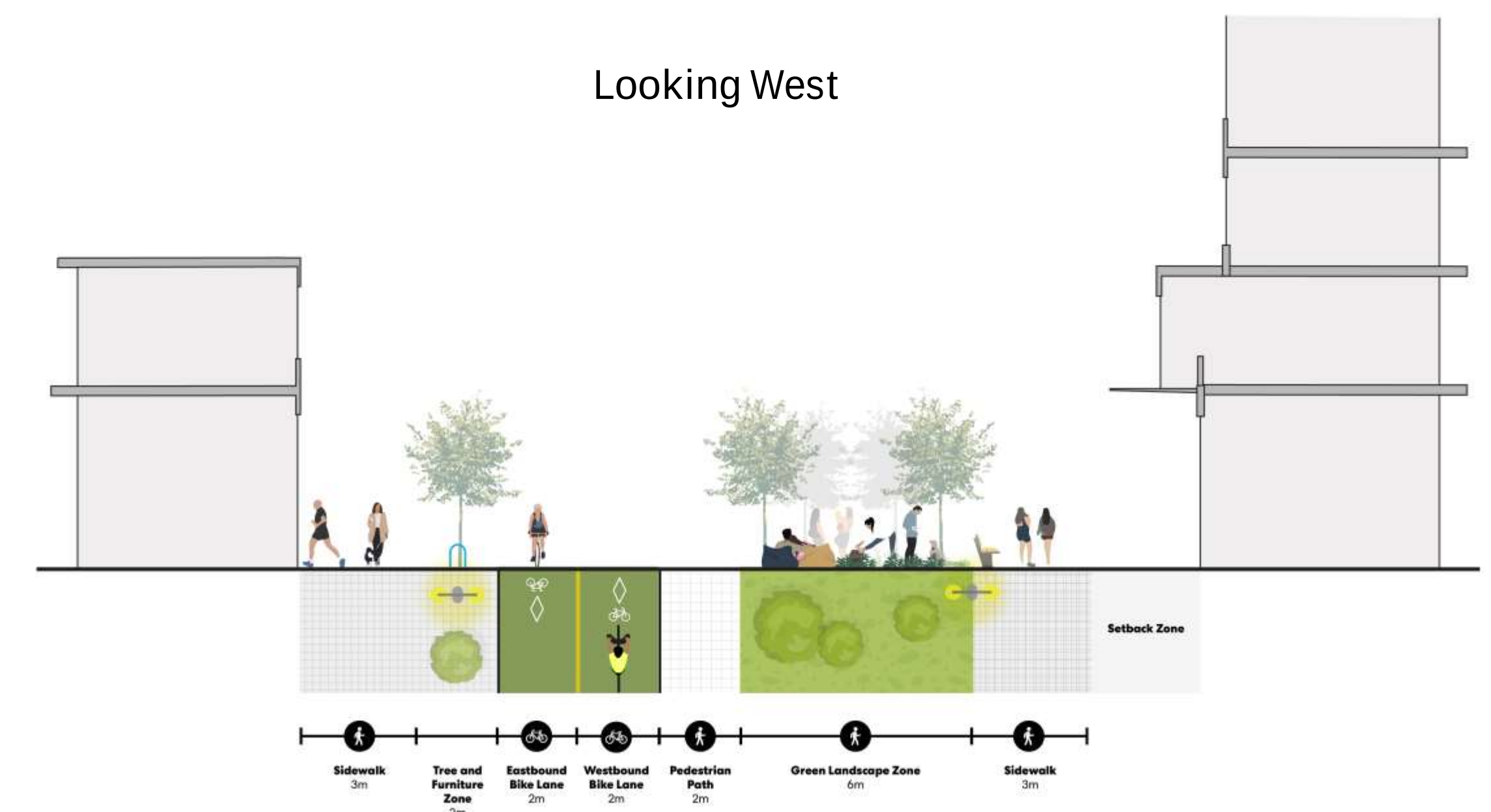

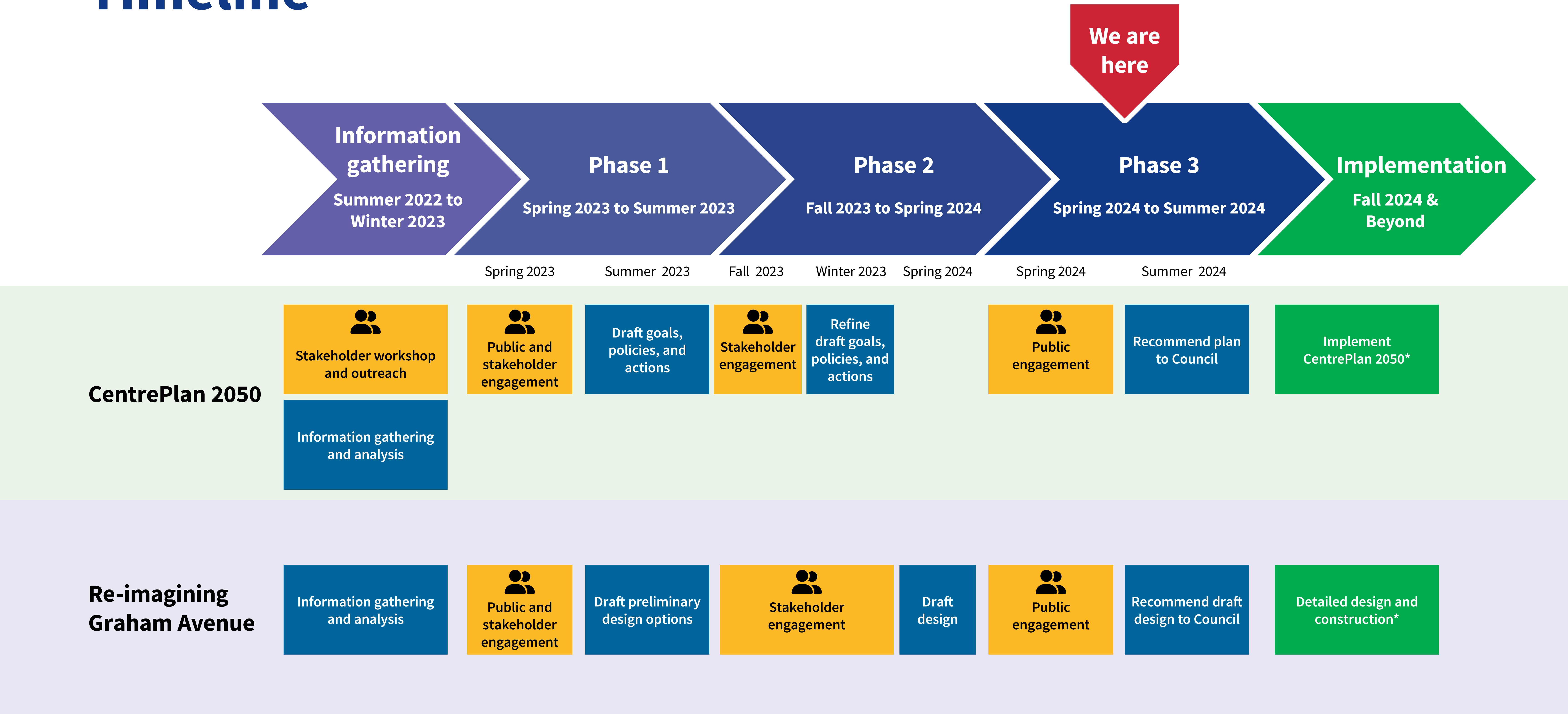
