Stay informed with Service Notices

Service notices provide daily operational updates, including information about delays, cancellations or schedule changes on your route. A service notice is posted to the BC Ferries website and distributed via email and mobile push notifications to subscribers to give warning of a potential cancellation, and once all the details of a cancellation or delay are known.



Sign up to receive service notices

To receive service notices to your email, create or sign into your BC Ferries account at bcferries.com/login and follow the steps below:

1. Select my subscriptions
2. Click on service notices
3. Select your routes
4. Save details

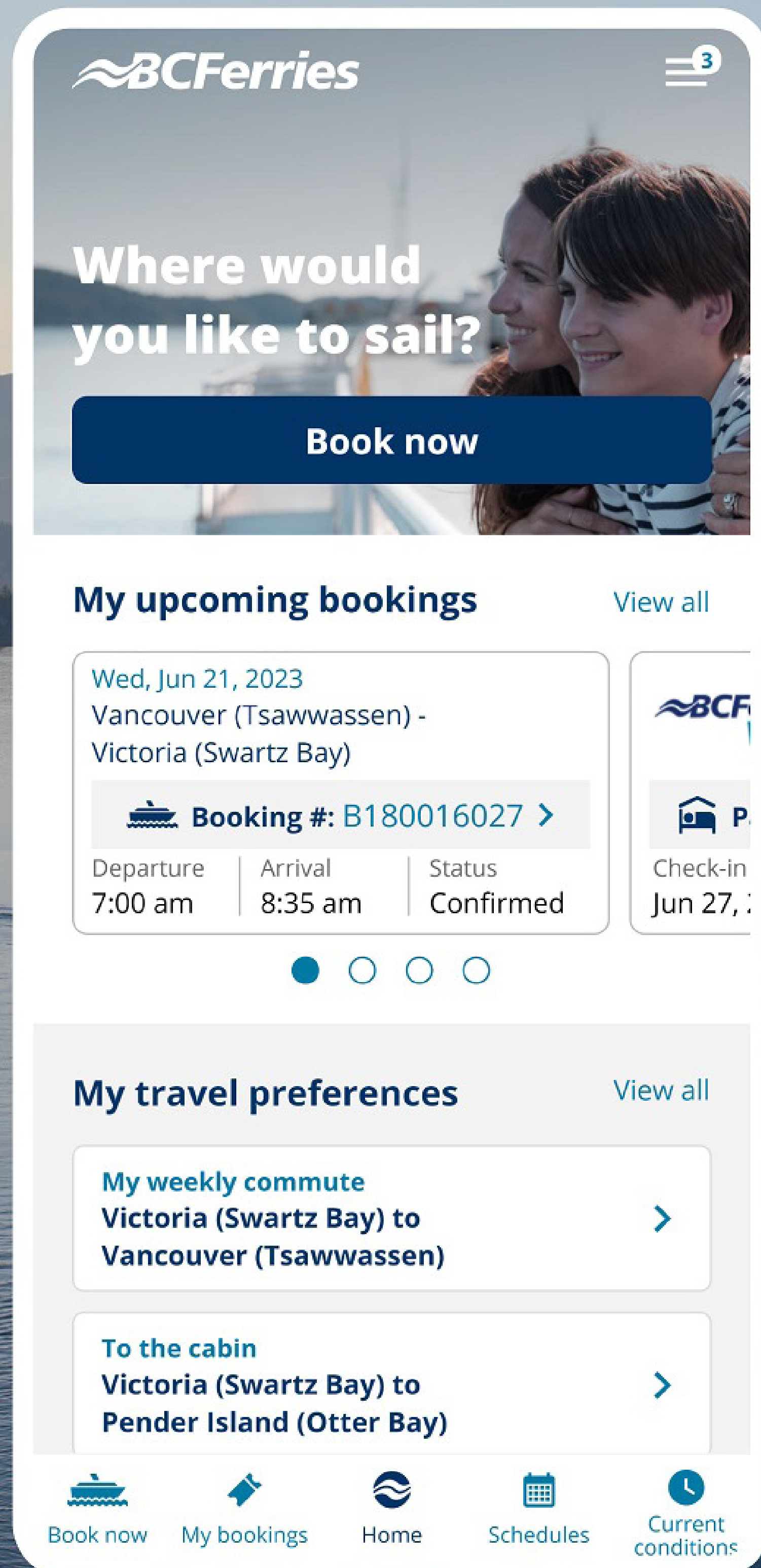

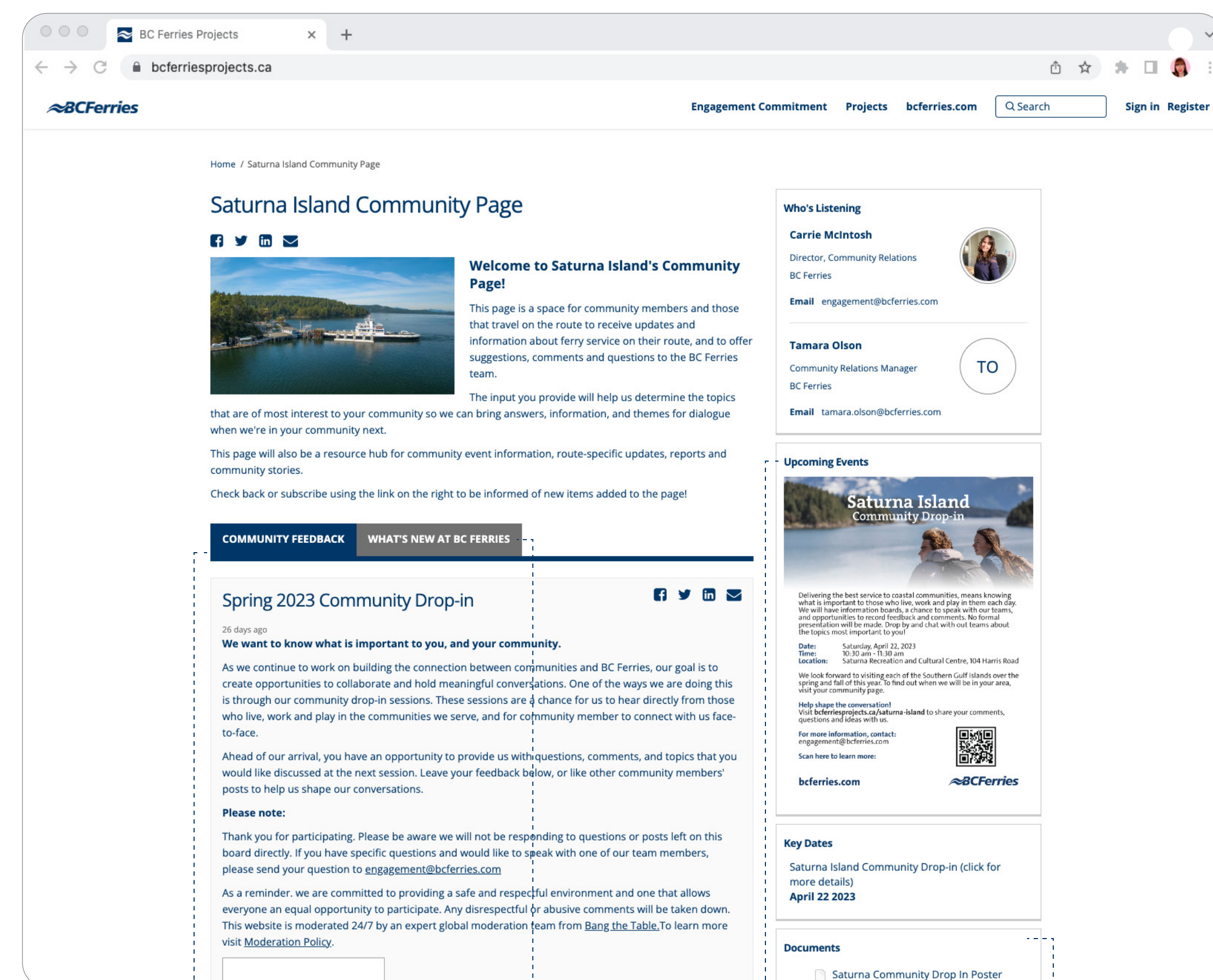
