 To consult on trip time options for serving Beecher Bay and Spirit Bay on route 64 starting in January 2022






Beecher Bay – Weekday Morning Service

- 6:00 pm, arriving in Beecher Bay at 6:30 pm







Observations, Impacts and Implications

Observation	Impact	Implication
Introduction of Saturday service is important, especially to those who currently use route 64	This priority will be carried forward	This was identified as a priority in the Sooke Local Area Transit Plan and will be carried forward
Weekday peak service (7-9 am, 3-6 pm), is most important to future riders	This will be carried forward as a priority for service to Beecher Bay and Spirit Bay	Additional service on to Beecher Bay and Spirit Bay would be prioritized on weekdays during peak times
