A usage-based funding model will mean that the amount each area contributes to a facility will be based on how much residents use it.

WHAT WILL THIS MEAN FOR YOU?

Because there are some areas currently overpaying for these recreational facilities, a new funding model will mean some areas pay less than they do now, and some will pay more.

MUNICIPALITY OF NORTH COWICHAN

\$56.99
CURRENT cost / \$100k home value

\$50.58
NEW usage-based cost / \$100k

-\$6.41
DIFFERENCE / \$100k

Average home value: **\$659,724**

CURRENT cost: **\$375.99** NEW usage-based cost: **\$333.71**

NOTE: Both current costs and usage-based costs are based on 2019 budget numbers to best represent normal expenditures from before the COVID-19 pandemic. The percentages of use by jurisdiction are based on the average between the 2017 and 2022 data collection cycles. Average home values are based on 2022 BC Assessment values.

VOTE ON THE NEW FUNDING MODEL

A referendum will be held on the new funding model. The question will be a part of the local government election.
